Weekly Fire Situation Report

17 February 2004

Fire Danger Rating	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ According to the current information we received from BMG for the six location, Nunukan and Tanjung Redep (Berau) are at High level, Tanjung Selor is at Moderate level, and Samarinda, Balikpapan and Tarakan are at Low level. <i>In average, the fire danger rating for East Kalimantan Province is at Moderate level.</i>
Hotspot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ According to the NOAA Satellite Images, which have been processed by UPTD PKHL, there was no hotspot detected in East Kalimantan. (most of the East Kalimantan area was covered by thick clouds as well as the poor quality images, which hampered the hotspots detection).
District Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ There was no forest or land fire occurrence reported. ➤ Districts were still experienced rain during last week.
Visibility, Temperature, Humidity, and Days Since Rain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The visibility in East Kalimantan is NORMAL 5-20 km ➤ The Temperature in general ranged between 25⁰ – 30⁰ C ➤ The Humidity in general ranged between 66 – 100 % ➤ The Days since Rain map showed that there were rains over the East Kalimantan during last week, but the intensity were different for each district.
Weather Forecast	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ It is predicted that the East Kalimantan <i>will still experience rain during this week</i> (09 – 16 February 2004), in general the condition will be fine weather, cloudy and humid. Except for Nunukan there is no information.
Readiness Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Base on those data above which have been calculated and analysis by UPTD PKHL, The preparedness level for East Kalimantan Province in general is NORMAL.
Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ There is no activity reported.
